- AZ Merit testing required
- Enrollment Deadline: Tuesday, May 28
- Grace Period Deadline: Friday, June 7

Summer Session 2: July 8-Aug 2 (20 days) (19-20 School Year)

- Enrollment Deadline: Tuesday, July 2
- Grace Period Deadline: Friday, July 12

AZ MERIT

Students must take the AZ Merit exam if enrolled in the following courses in Session 1

- ELA 9 Part B
- ELA 10 Part B
- ELA 11 Part B
- Algebra I Part B
- Geometry Part B
- Algebra II Part B

WHAT DO STUDENTS NEED TO ENROLL?

As this program is supported by state funds when a student enrolls the following documents are required:

- Student Birth Certificate
- Parent Photo ID (may be used for AZ Proof of Residency)
- Proof of Residency
- Immunization (Only required if enrolling in an AZ Merit Course)
